# Third Sunday in Ordinary Time January 21, 2018

Jesus came to Galilee proclaiming the Gospel of God: "This is the time of fulfillment. The kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe the Gospel." He said to Simon and his brother, Andrew, "Come after me, and I will make you fishers of men." Mark 1:14-20

Christ entrusts to each one of us - nun, fisherman, doctor, cook, teacher, student, pastor, laborer, child, senior - the work of discipleship - to proclaim, in our own time and place, the compassion, justice and forgiveness of the Gospel. Christ came to show us how it is possible to live life to the fullest, if we dare to make selfless charity and reconciliation the center of our lives. That is the challenge of the disciple's call - to find our life's fulfillment in using our skills and knowledge for the common good rather than for personal profit or fame; to seek reconciliation and forgiveness when the rest of the world demands vengeance and settling the score; to see Christ in the faces of those who have been written off by society; to embrace the role of servant when the conventional wisdom dictates "me first."

Our weary souls desperately seek transformation, newness, change. The Gospel Jesus comes with is the "good news" that our God loves us like a father loves his children, that God seeks not our humiliation but our reconciliation with Him. Jesus is the Messiah who establishes the reign of God through forgiveness, reconciliation and selfless charity - in Jesus, the time for hope in God's justice and forgiveness has come. Jesus calls us to "abandon" our "nets" of self-centeredness, fear and despair and walk with Him to become "fishers" of the life and love of God.


