"Witnesses"

As the Risen Jesus appears to the Eleven "as flesh and bone," Jesus calls us to be "flesh and bone" witnesses of His Resurrection. Jesus asks us to live His Gospel of peace and reconciliation in the simplicity of our everyday lives, in the complexities of our work places, in the struggle to realize our hopes and dreams for ourselves and our families.

To be a witness of Christ is not simply to repeat what we have heard but to give our whole lives as evidence of the truth. Belief in the Resurrected Lord can't be argued or explained to someone. Even Jesus didn't try that. He knew that the truth of His Resurrection had to be seen, had to be touched, had to be experienced in the flesh. We are witnesses when we can invite someone to look into our homes, our families, our friendships, our work, our day-timers and find Jesus there. May our works of generosity and compassion, our commitment to what is right and good, our struggle to forgive and heal defy any explanation other than the presence of the Risen Christ in our midst.


