## June 10, 2018

*"How can Satan drive out Satan? If a kingdom is divided against itself, that kingdom cannot stand. And if a house is divided against itself, that house will not be able to stand..." "...whoever blasphemes against the Holy Spirit will never have forgiveness, but is guilty of everlasting sin."* Mark 3: 20-35



Sometimes we act out of a self-centeredness that is of "Satan" and not out of the compassionate spirit of the Gospel we profess - without fail, the "house" we build out of arrogance and greed collapses in anger and hurt. The "symphony" we try to orchestrate from our own wants and interests disintegrates into a noisy tangle of out-of-sync instruments. If a house that is a real home is to stand, it must be constructed of forgiveness, humility, and generosity. If we are to play the music that God places in every human heart, we must welcome and encourage everyone to raise their voices and contribute the sound and skill of their instruments. Let the reconciling and loving Spirit of God be the architect of the "houses" we seek to make for ourselves and families, the conductor of creation's song of peace and healing sung by every human life and heart.




