"If anyone wishes to be first, he shall be last and the servant of all..." "Whoever receives one child such as this in my name, receives me; and whoever receives me, receives not me but the One who sent me." Mark 9: 30-37

The child represents for the disciples of Jesus the vulnerabilities, fears, and doubts that every one of us experiences in our lives; and the child reminds us of Jesus' call to us as His disciples to take up His work of reaching out to those overwhelmed by such anxiety and despair. In the service we give and respect, we afford to others as sons and daughters of God, Jesus says, we welcome into our midst the very presence of God. Our empathy and care for the child and child-like in our midst mirrors the love of God for us despite our own failings and fears.

Christ calls us to embrace the simple but profound faith that we seek to teach our children: to love God and one another with honesty and faithfulness, without condition or expectation, putting aside every "adult" rationalization and agenda. Only in "opening" our own hearts to Jesus' Gospel of uncomplicated and straightforward kindness, compassion, generosity and forgiveness, can we help our sons and daughters become authentic followers of the Jesus of selflessness and compassion.

The <u>Called</u> to <u>Protect</u> program presents abuse prevention information to parents, children, youth and young adults.

<u>Called to Protect for Youth</u> teaches middle school and high school aged students about boundaries, how to respond if someone tries to violate their boundaries, and how to tell their parents if they or their friend have been abused. The <u>Called to Protect for Youth</u> program will take place in two parts. Part I on Tuesday, October 2, 7:00 pm - 8:30 pm. Part II on Tuesday, October 9, 7:00 pm - 8:30 pm.

Both meetings take place at Saint Clement Parish Hall. Parents are asked to attend with their student. If you have attended this meeting in the past, it is not necessary to attend again. **Please RSVP by October 1**.

Called to Protect for Young Children teaches appropriate information to children in elementary school. The students will learn rules about protecting their bodies and what to do if someone tries to break the rules. The content and teaching methods use the latest child development research to ensure their effectiveness. The **Called to Protect for Young Children** is offered to families annually in the course of the Parish Family PSR program.

<u>Called to Protect for Parents and Families</u> teaches parents what to watch for and the actions to take if they see something of concern. They also learn how to begin to communicate with their children about their bodies and how to keep them safe. Children's Liturgy of the Word



Did you know that we have Children's Liturgy of the Word at St. Clement? On Sunday at the 9:00 am Mass, we celebrate Children's Liturgy.

Have you ever wondered what happens at the Children's Liturgy of the Word? After the opening prayers, and before the first reading, Father will call the children to the front. We process out to the gathering area where we have a table covered in the liturgical color and a lit candle to represent the presence of Jesus. The children sit and listen to the readings, they respond to the psalm, they stand for the Alleluia, and listen to the Gospel. These readings are the same as the adult Mass, but are translated for children. The children then share a word that they heard in one of the readings and we share our thoughts. We conclude with intentions where each child has the opportunity to say who they would like to pray for. After the gifts have been taken up, we rejoin the congregation.

Who is welcome? All children are welcome. We do not have a strict age rule. However, the average age would be 3 to 12. Ideally, the child needs to be able to sit, listen, and participate. We also welcome parents that would like to sit with their children. We hope to see you all next Sunday!
