# The Baptism of the Lord

## January 12, 2020

*Jesus came up from the water and behold, the heavens were opened for Him, and He saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and coming upon Him. And a voice came from the heavens, saying, "This is my beloved Son with whom I am well pleased." Matthew 3: 13 -17*

At our Baptism, those who love us prayed that we will embrace the Spirit - the very Spirit of the Creator's love. In Christ, we come to realize who we are and whose we are - sons and daughters of God. In Baptism, we take on the work of the name "Christian"; to live for others rather than ourselves; to seek the will of God in all things. The Baptism we received, however many years ago, was not just a naming ceremony but an ongoing commitment that continues every day of our journey to the dwelling place of God. Baptism calls us to declare, without hesitation or equivocation, that we are disciples of the Jesus of the Gospel of justice, reconciliation and servanthood. In the waters of the sacrament, we begin our journey back to the God who gives us this life in the first place. In the waters of Baptism, we embrace the name of "Christ" and the Spirit of His Gospel that unites us to the saints who have come before us and who will come after us. In these waters, we travel through life's deserts and meadows, in struggling trickles and powerful rivers to the ocean where one day we "return" to God. Baptism is not just a one-time rite of passage in our lives - it is an ongoing journey with God, a sojourn across the waters to the heavens where God dwells.

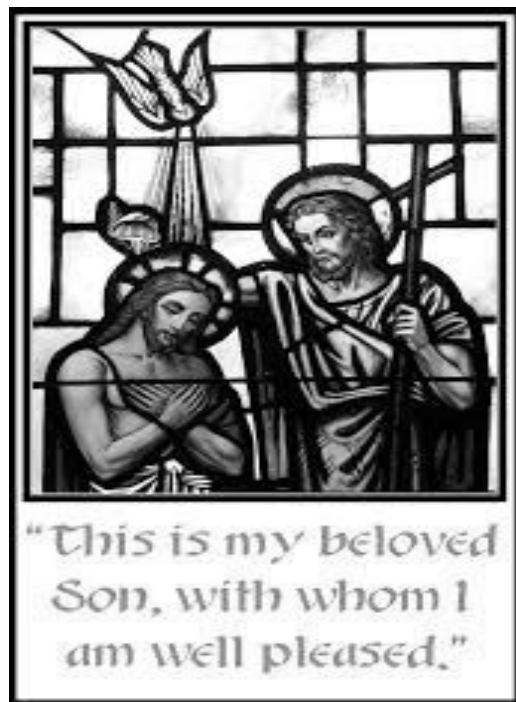
*In Baptism, we are embraced in the Spirit of life and love that is of God; we become the voice of the God who speaks compassion and peace to our hearts. We take on the hard work of revealing God's love in our midst; we pick up the prophetic mantle of John the Baptizer to create a highway for God to enter our homes and hearts. Today's feast of Jesus' Baptism calls us to recommit ourselves to our Baptisms - to give voice to love that struggles to be heard, to mend broken hearts and spirits so that God can be found within.*

As of January 6th, the Diocese of Cleveland officially sold a portion of the Saint Clement property to Liberty Development. This past week, the separating of the electrical service was done. All electrical service for the church now comes from Lincoln Avenue, with new electrical panels installed. The asbestos abatement was completed in the school and convent.

This coming week, Liberty Development is planning to begin the demolition of the school and convent. Construction fencing will surround the buildings. Access to the church will be adjusted as the demolition develops. At least for the weekend Masses and funerals, one handicap entrance will be available. With regards to the parking, we ask for patience as we work that out.

Thank you for your support and patience as the new landscape around our church unfolds.

The next Cleveland Retrouvaille Weekend is scheduled for **January 24th - 26th, 2020**.

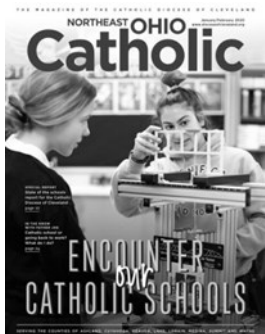
This is a lifeline for troubled marriages.
