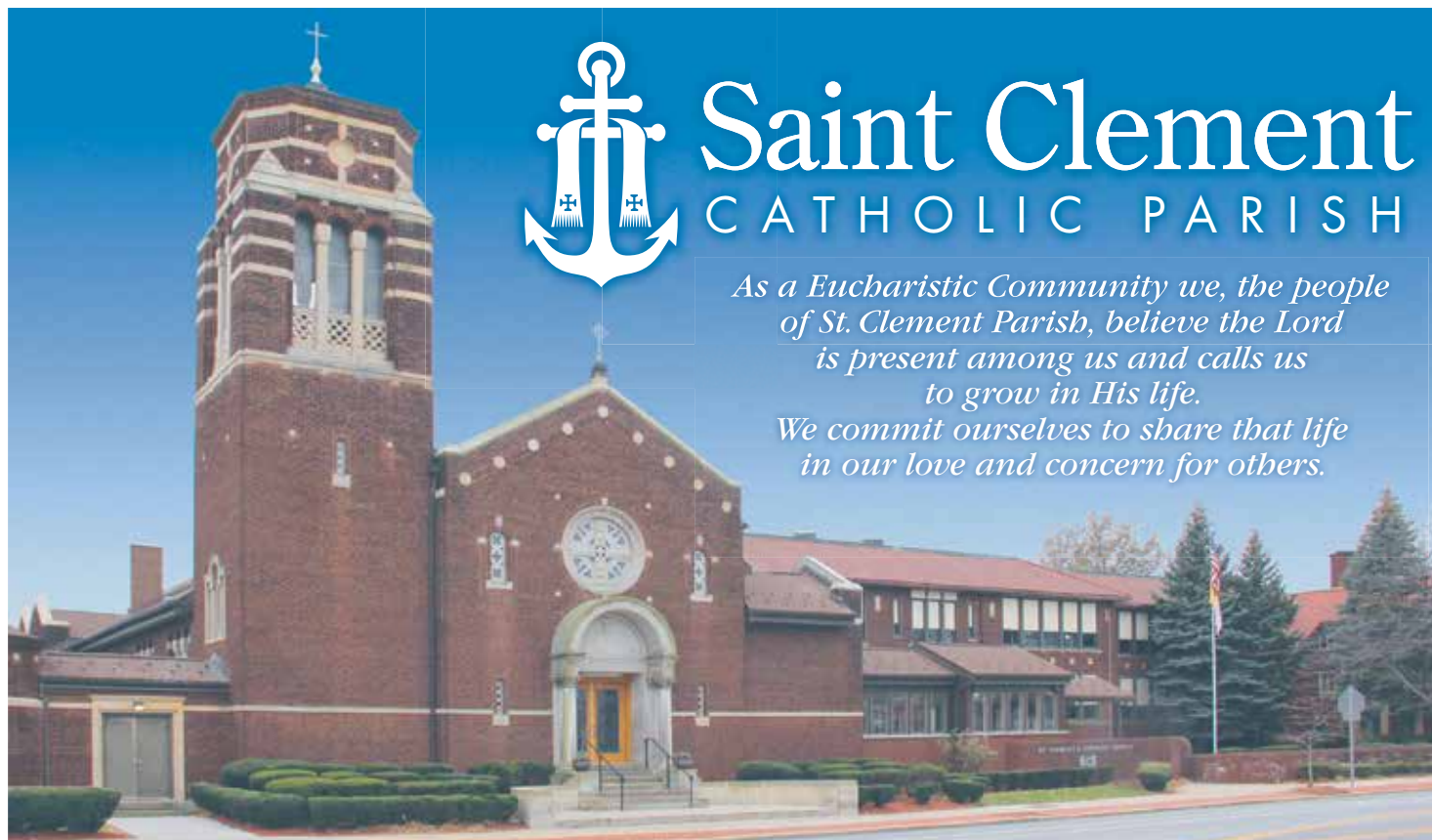

# Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time

## February 16, 2020

*"Amen, I say to you, until heaven and earth pass away, not the smallest letter or the smallest part of a letter will pass from the law, until all things have taken place." "Therefore, whoever breaks one of the least of these commandments and teaches others to do so will be called least in the kingdom of heaven. But whosoever obeys and teaches commandments will be called greatest in the kingdom of heaven..." "Let your 'Yes' mean 'Yes' and your 'No' mean 'No.'"*

Matthew 5: 17-37

Today's Gospel is about attitude and perspective. Jesus asks us to consider not just our failings and sins - the acts themselves - but the self-centeredness at the heart of our actions. To embrace happiness is a choice we make; we decide whether or not to engage the world with a perspective of hope and possibility. Jesus challenges us to confront the anger, the bigotry, the self-righteousness that we use to justify our selfish behavior; the attitudes that tear families and communities apart, that destroy our own sense of self-respect as well as diminishing the basic human dignity of others. To follow Jesus is to see the possibilities we have for doing good things and to accept God's grace to make such good a reality.
