Our own fears of change, our own struggles to make sense of a constantly evolving world too often are allowed to slowly kill our hope, our enthusiasm, our spirit. 

#### CYO Fall Sports

Registration for fall sports is now open. The decision on whether fall sports will be played and what each sport will look like is beyond LCA's control, but we need to begin planning for that season as if it will take place in its full capacity. Note that payment for fall sports is not required at this time. For each sport offered, there are two payment options. Families are permitted to pay now, but we encourage families to choose the second option, which delays payment until July. The pay-now-option is a default in the registration system we use, and cannot be removed as an option. For our spring student-athletes, we are still in the process of finalizing credits and refunds, a process that has been slow due to the large number of families involved.




