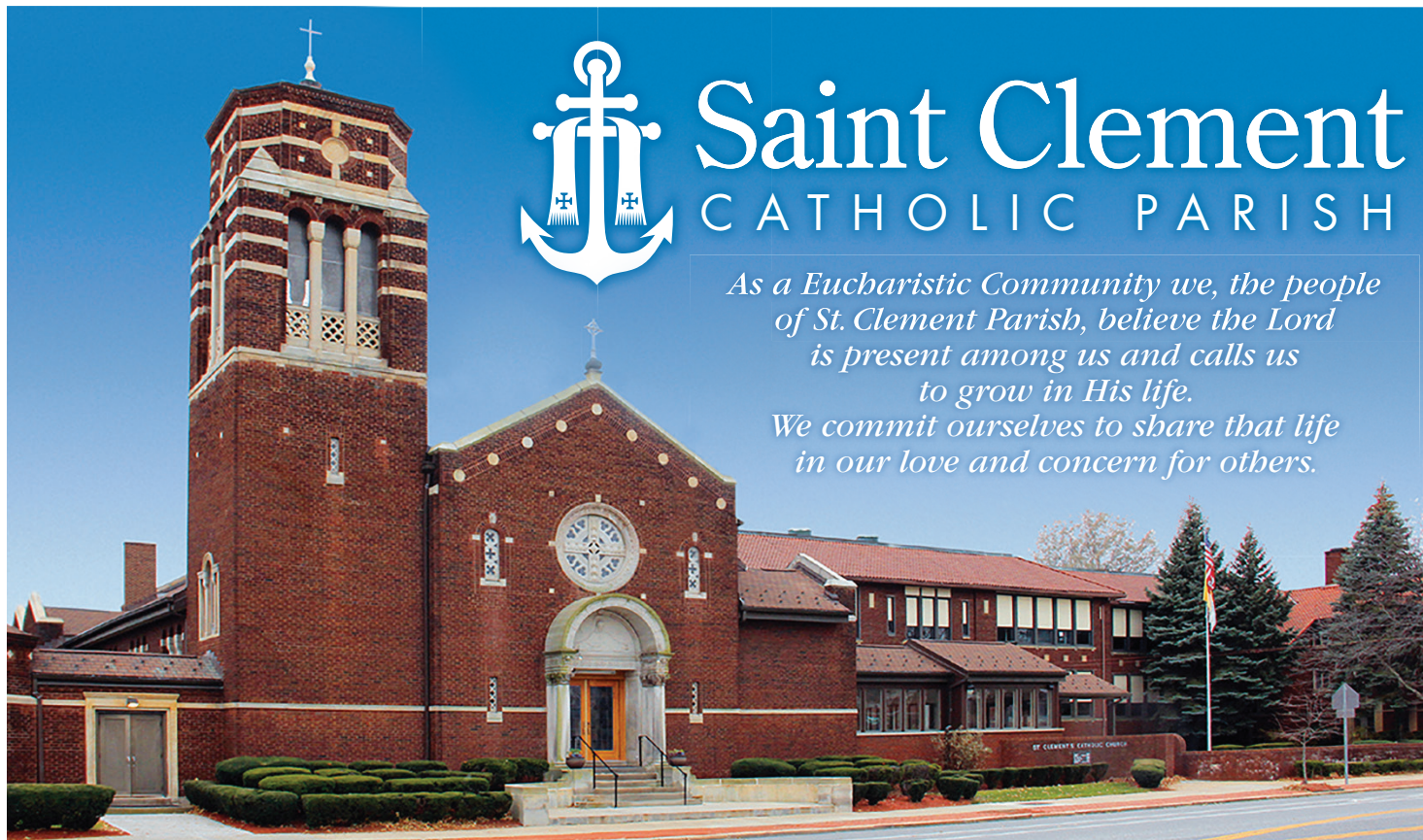

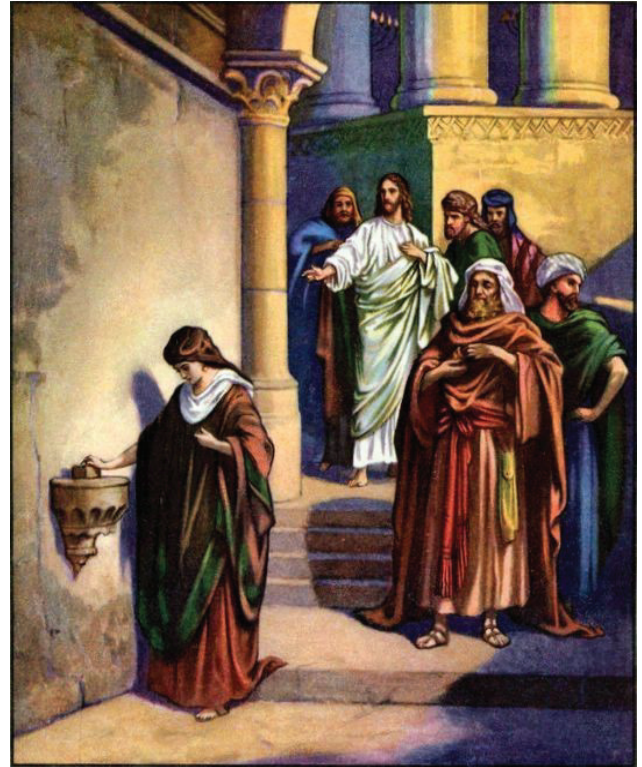
Thirty-Second Sunday of the Year

"Beware of the scribes, who like to go around in long robes and accept greetings in the marketplaces, seats of honor in synagogues, and places of honor at banquets..." "This poor widow put in more than all the other contributors to the treasury. For they have all contributed from their surplus wealth, but she, from her poverty..." Mark 12: 38-44

God's Footprint

Before creation, our own sense of entitled honor fades; caught up in the love of God, our sense of self diminishes. Humility is to recognize the "footprint" of God in our midst; such as Jesus-like humility is the heart of discipleship. The Kingdom of God is realized only in our embracing Christ's spirit of humble servanthood – servanthood that finds fulfillment in the love, compassion and kindness we can extend to others, servanthood that puts the common good before self-interest and profit, servanthood that compels us to place the needs of others less fortunate than ourselves above our own wants and narrow interests. The faithful disciple of Jesus honors the dignity of the servant over the power of the rich, canonizes generous humility over cynical celebrity, and finds inspiration in the total generosity of the widow rather than the empty gestures of the scribe. May we seek to lead and follow in the spirit of Jesus, to reveal the "footprint" of God's compassion in our own seeking of reconciliation rather than vengeance, justice rather than convention, selflessness rather than self-interest.

A Church That Listens

Pope Francis has asked the universal Church to enter into a synodal process to discern, through a journey of listening and accompaniment, how we can be more fully a Church on mission to proclaim the Kingdom. The experience of the Diocese of Cleveland has something to share in this in its own practice of pastoral planning through collaborative engagement with the whole People of God. The Institute of Catholic Studies at John Carroll University is pleased to present a panel discussion of this earlier example of our diocese engaging in such a journey.
