

Third Sunday of Lent March 20, 2022

The parable of the barren fig tree: "Sir, leave the tree for this year also, and I shall cultivate the ground around it and fertilize it; it may bear fruit in the future."

Luke 13: 1-9

There are many "gaps" in our lives - places where we lose our way, times when we are hurting, spaces in which we find ourselves alone and abandoned, abysses of despair and doubt and cynicism. 
