

<u>Fífth Sunday of Lent</u> <u>Apríl 3, 2022</u>

"Let the one among you who is without sin be the first to throw a stone at her." John 8: 1-11

Christ calls us to embrace a new perspective of humankind - that we are brothers and sisters to one another; that we are called not to be judges or selfappointed executors of God's wrath on others (God reserves that to Himself), but to be agents of God's forgiveness and reconciliation; that we should find no satisfaction in the fall of sinners, but should only be satisfied when we have done all we can to lift them up and restore them to hope. "Hate the sin but love the sinner" is easier said than done. We're capable of justifying the destruction and exile of anyone who does not meet our standards of conduct. But to be faithful disciples of the Easter Christ is to drop our stones of condemnation and self-righteousness and help restore and heal the lost, the troubled, the disappointed with whom we share the compassion of God.
