<u>ASCENSION OF THE LORD</u> <u>MAY 29, 2022</u>

"You are witnesses of these things."

Luke 24: 46-53

The Spirit of the Risen Christ walks among us, inspiring us, motivating us, compelling us to take on the work of being His witnesses and proclaimers of His Gospel.
