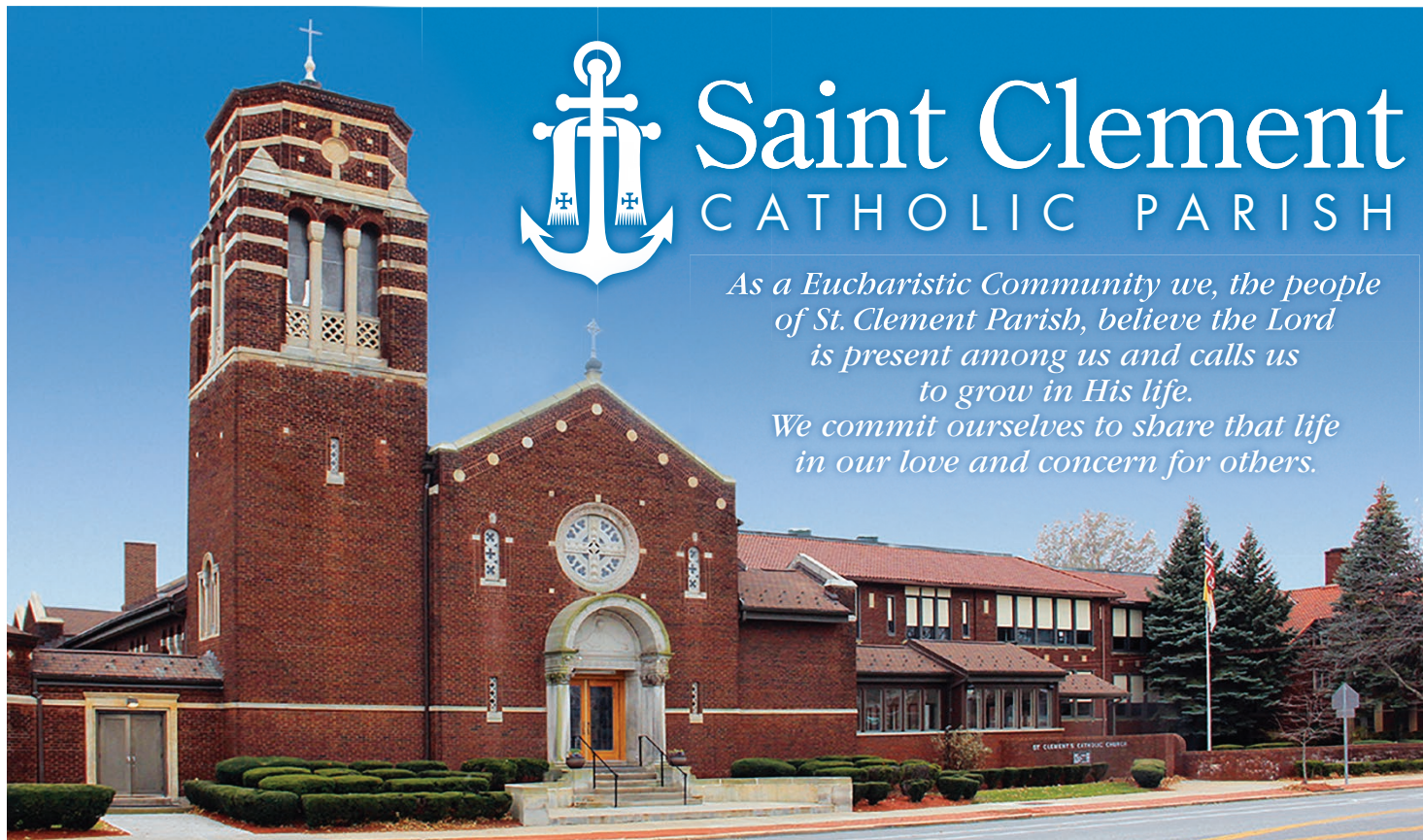

The Lord appointed seventy-two others whom He sent ahead of Him in pairs to every town and place He intended to visit. "Into whatever house you enter, first say, 'Peace to this household...'" "Whatever town you enter and they welcome you, eat what is set before you, cure the sick and say to them, 'The kingdom of God is at hand for you.' "

In today's Gospel, Jesus sends forth the seventy-two to proclaim the kingdom of God. Their mission is not about power but peace; it is grounded not in dominance but in humble service. They are sent forth not to condemn or chide but to heal and lift up. They are to mirror in their attitude and work the humble, generous love of God they proclaim. They are to walk among and with those they are sent to serve – the difference is the "song" of compassion and reconciliation and hope they carry. In our love for others, God resides in us; in the kindness and care, we are able to extend to others the very presence of God is realized. Jesus entrusts that "song" to all of us whom He sends forth to proclaim the Father's kingdom.
