<u>Twenty-first Sunday of the Year</u> <u>August 21, 2022</u>

"Strive to enter through the narrow gate, for many, I tell you, will attempt to enter but will not be strong enough."

Luke 13: 22-30

Discipline and sacrifice are the hinges of the "narrow gate" that Jesus speaks of in today's Gospel. All of the important things of life demand that we struggle through the narrow gate. There are no magic words to loving and being loved, to creating a world of justice and peace, to forgiving and being reconciled with one another. promises that anyone willing to struggle through the "narrow gate" will come to experience the life of God to the fullest. Our entry into the life of God requires of us an honesty and integrity that we cannot ignore or rationalize in order to justify our passage. The "narrow gate" is what we believe, what we hear God asking of us in the depth of our hearts. The "narrow gate" allows for no acceptable margin of error, no "wiggle room," no path of least resistance. It is the difficult way of limitless love, forgiveness, and unconditional sacrificial selflessness. Jesus promises that anyone willing to struggle through the "narrow gate" will be welcome into the eternal dwelling place of His Father.


