<u>Twenty-Fifth Sunday of the Year</u> <u>September 18, 2022</u>

The parable of the dishonest steward. Luke 16: 1-13

In the parable of the shrewd manager, Jesus asks us what drives us, what inspires us, what moves us to act. Profit and security are important, to be sure - but for the disciple of Jesus, the good we are able to bring about, the work we are able to do in order to bring God's reign of justice and compassion to reality, should be the motivating force in our lives. Our lives find their meaning and purpose not in the estates we build for our own glory but in what we are able to contribute to the common good and progress of humankind. Jesus calls us beyond our comfort zones to take up the cross of selflessness and compassion. He urges us to risk everything in order to realize the love of God in all things. Faith calls us not merely to avoid the "thou shalt nots", but to take on the demanding but rewarding work of Gospel reconciliation, justice and mercy.
