The parable of Lazarus and the rich man. Luke 16: 19-31

Jesus' story about Lazarus and the rich man seems to belong to a time long ago and a place far away, but the fact is that there are many Lazaruses at our own gates whom we overlook, ignore, and dismiss. Lazarus may be sitting at the desk right next to us; Lazarus may even be sitting at our dinner table every night. Today's Gospel challenges us to remove the blinders of self-centeredness from our eyes and hearts to see God in our midst in the poor, the forgotten, the isolated, the marginalized; to realize the dignity of every human being as created in the image of God; to possess the humility that enables us to embrace one another as brothers and sisters, sons and daughters of God.


