## <u>Thirty-second Sunday in Ordinary Time</u> <u>November 6, 2022</u>

"...they are the children of God because they are the ones who will rise." "The Lord is not God of the dead but of the living, for to Him all are alive." Luke 20: 27-38

Our November gardens reflect the hope Jesus speaks of in today's Gospel. God is not a god of death or endings, but God of new beginning and constant recreation.
