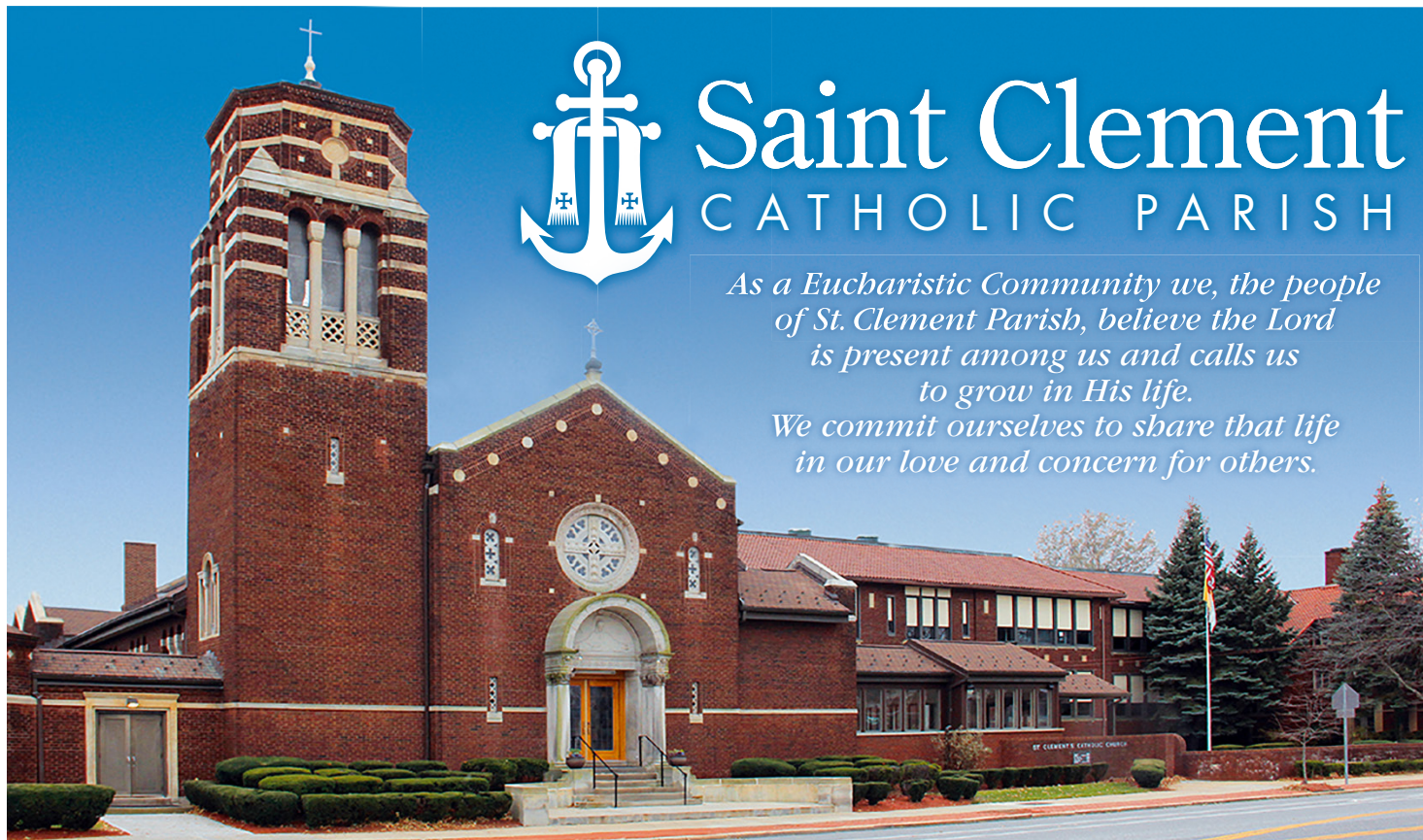

Thirty-second Sunday in Ordinary Time

November 6, 2022

"...they are the children of God because they are the ones who will rise." "The Lord is not God of the dead but of the living, for to Him all are alive." Luke 20: 27-38

Our November gardens reflect the hope Jesus speaks of in today's Gospel. God is not a god of death or endings, but God of new beginning and constant re-creation. Our God is not a God of condemnation and retribution; God calls us to neither condemn or seek vengeance. Our God is a God of love that redeems and transforms and calls us to love one another in the same way. Resurrection is the promise and hope of our faith as Christians, but resurrection is also an attitude, a perspective for approaching life and sorting out the decisions and complexities of our lives. In our willingness to die to our own worst impulses, disappointments, and the sometimes overwhelming sense of hopelessness, we can rise to the heights of the life and love of God. God always calls us to start again, to put aside old behaviors and wants and embrace all that is good and affirming about the time we have been given, to live on in the hope that the struggles we encounter in this life are but a prelude to the fullness of joy in the next.
