"The days will come when there will not be left a stone upon another stone that will not be thrown down..." "I myself shall give you a wisdom in speaking that all our adversaries will be powerless to resist or refute. " Luke 21: 5-19

Today's Gospel challenges us to consider what drives us, what things we risk our lives for. In the end, what will be found that will define our lives? In His Christ, God calls us to seek much more precious and lasting gifts than this world is capable of offering treasures like compassion, reconciliation, justice and peace. What is required first, however, is to give up the attitudes and avarices that make possessing the things of God impossible. Jesus calls us not to be obsessed with the "stones" that will one day collapse and become dust, but to seek instead the lasting things of the soul - the things of God.
