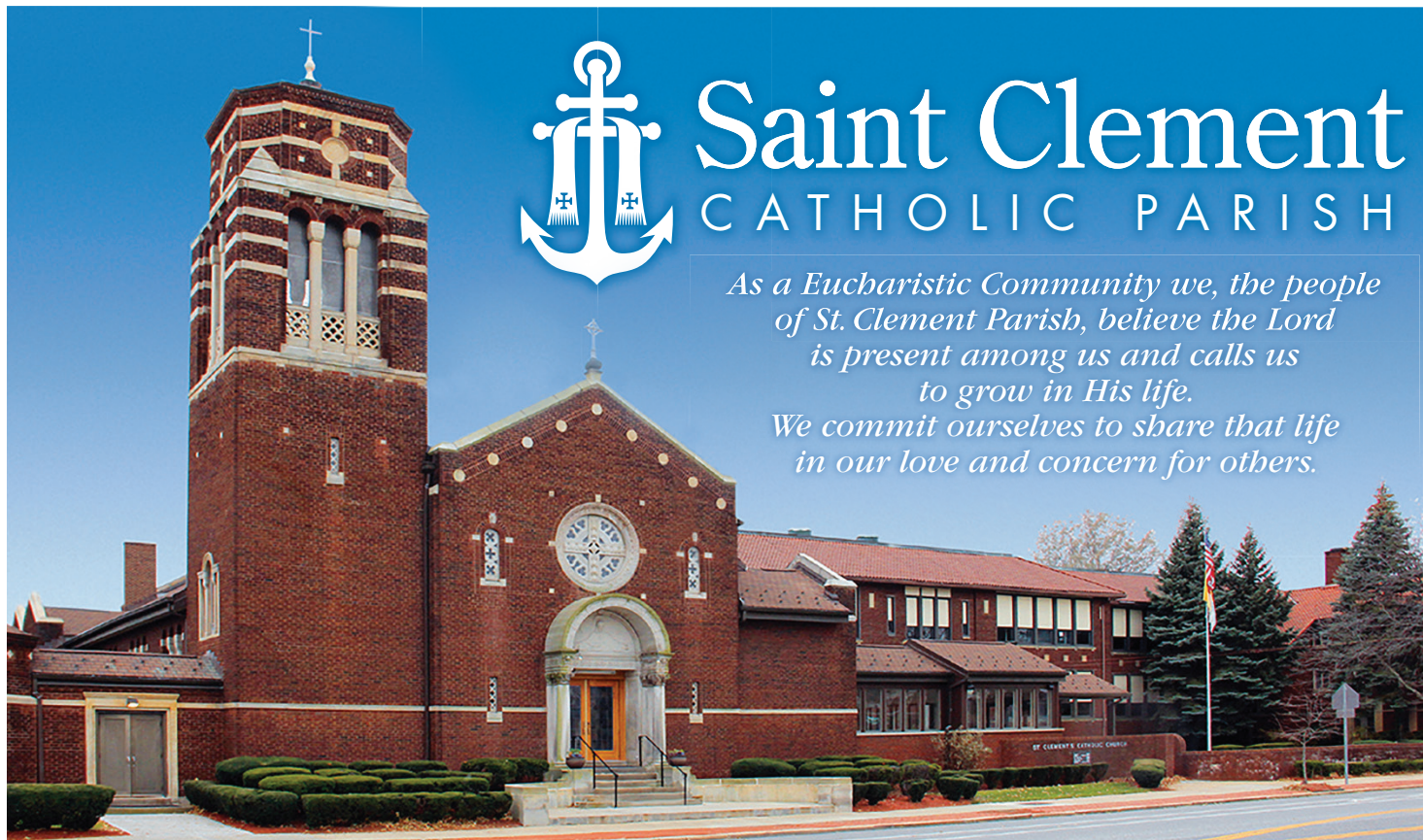

".... whoever obeys and teaches these commandments will be called greatest in the kingdom of heaven. I tell you, unless your righteousness surpasses that of the scribes and Pharisees, you will not enter the kingdom of heaven. Let your 'Yes' mean 'Yes' and your 'No' mean 'No'." Matthew 5: 17-37

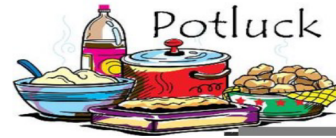
