# First Sunday of Lent February 26, 2023

Jesus was led by the Spirit into the desert to be tempted by the devil: "If you are the Son of God, command that these stones become loaves of bread...throw yourself down...all these I shall give to you, if you will prostrate yourself and worship me." Matthew 4: 1-11

Our Lenten desert experience is a time for striking that balance between realizing our humility before God and our identity as God's beloved. When we are consumed by the notion that we are in total control of our lives, when we are arrogantly self-absorbed because of what we possess and what we have achieved, we should remember - I am dust and ashes. But when we feel abandoned, when hope seems far away, when we feel lost in the Lenten wilderness, we need to embrace the message I am God's beloved; I am created in God's image.

May these next six weeks before Easter be a time for striking that balance in our lives - a balance between humility that leads to selflessness and joy in the everpresent love of God in our midst.
