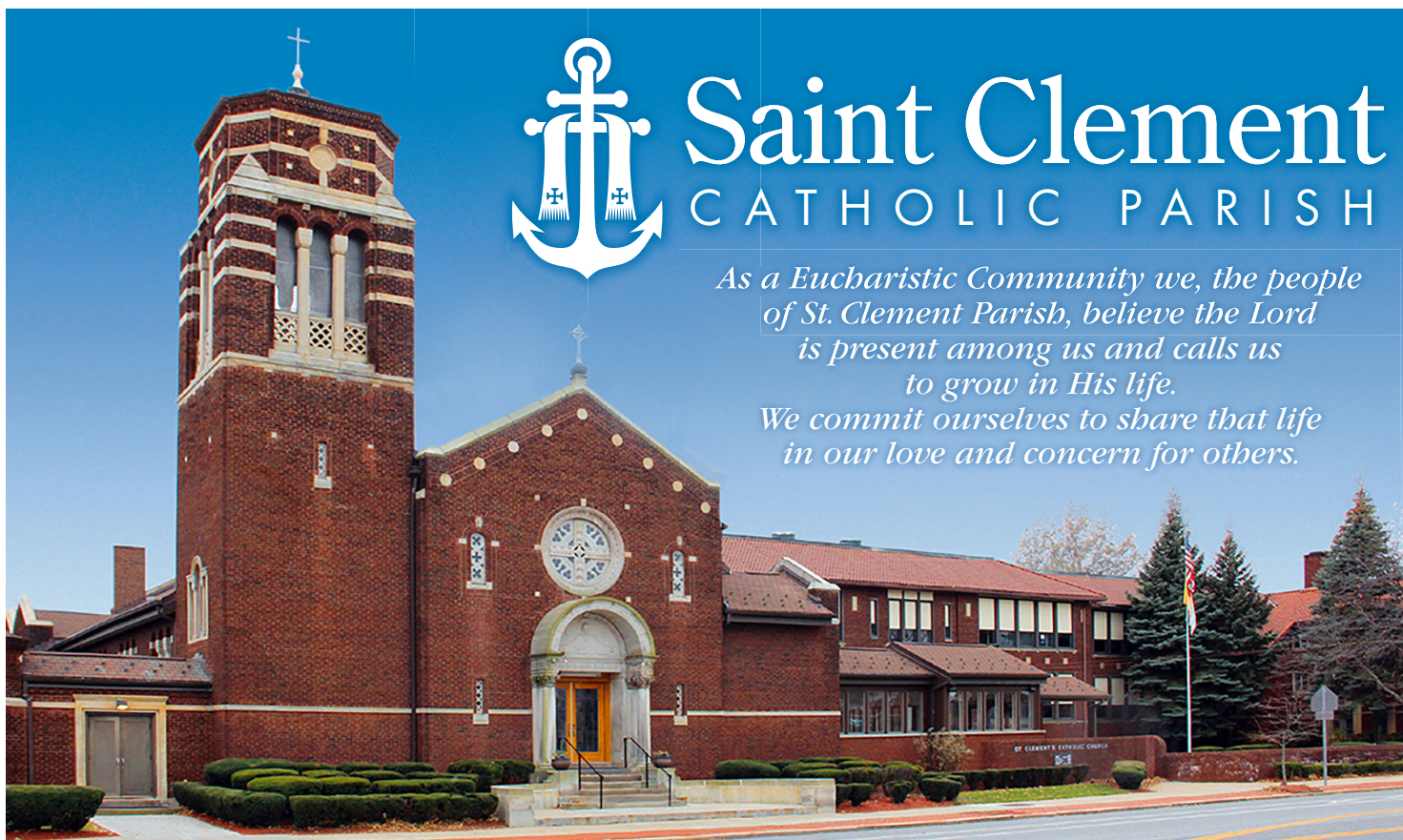

Thirty-Second Sunday of the Year

November 12, 2023

"The kingdom of heaven will be like ten virgins who took their lamps and went out to meet the bridegroom..."
Matthew 25: 1-13

In these final Sundays of the liturgical year, Jesus speaks to us of "last things," of the transition from life as we know it to the life of God in eternity. The parable of the ten bridesmaids illustrates the precariousness and the preciousness of the time we are given to live lives that "matter." There is so much we want to do with our lives, but the demands on our time to make a living derail us from making a life - a life that is centered in the love of family and friends, a life that is lived in the constant awareness of God's loving presence, a life that finds its fulfillment in contributing to the greater good of all. Christ warns us not to fall into the trap of the five "foolish" bridesmaids who squander their time before the bridegroom arrives, but to embrace the wisdom of the five "wise" bridesmaids, trimming our "lamps" with the "oil" of compassion, generosity and forgiveness in the precious time we have until His coming.
