Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Once again I take this opportunity to share with you the financials of Saint Clement Parish that were reported to the Diocese for this past financial year. As you will notice, the parish continues to be financially stable and is even able to build some savings for unexpected future expenses. I am very grateful for all the many ways people support the financial needs of our Parish. In particular, I would like to thank those who are part of the Finance Council. Their knowledge and support have been invaluable over the past years.

During this particular financial year, which is from July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016, we have been able to accomplish some major projects. These include the new drain at the front entrance on Madison; completing the cleaning of the exterior sandstone and tuck pointing of the south and west sides of the church; stripping and resealing the church hall and kitchen floors, replacement of a compressor in one of the air conditioning units; the purchase of a new convection oven; and a new sidewalk in front of the Rectory. In addition to these major projects, because of your continued generosity, the continued up keep of the parking lot, roofs, elevator, office needs and other general maintenance projects keeps our property safe and well maintained. I am so grateful to have the financial support to do the work that comes up without worrying or having to make shortcuts.

However, there are always projects and unexpected maintenance that develop. We are currently installing a new fire suppression system in the kitchen and reinstalling the refurbished exterior door to the Sacristy. Future projects are installing a new air conditioner/heater for the gathering area; a new door for the chapel; renovation of the hall restrooms; new landscaping in the front of the church; and cleaning of the sandstone and tuck pointing of the Rectory.

But what about the school building and convent? This is a question that many people are asking. As you may remember in past years we were working with Catholic Charities to develop the current buildings into low income senior housing. After applying for state funding twice and being denied support, I was forced to abandoned that project. However, this past summer I was approached by a developer interested in the property for a client who is looking for office space. After discussions with Bishop Lennon and other Diocesan individuals, I have decided to continue discussions with the developer. Though we are just at the beginning, there seems to be great potential. The general scope of the project would be to sell off some of the property to the developer, who will then tear down the existing buildings, and, subsequently, build an office building on the corner of Madison and Marlowe. This will leave us with closer parking and green space along the west side of the Church. The architecture of the new office building will take into account the previous school and the Church architecture. This, I believe, will be a good use of the space and will enhance the beauty of the Church. I ask you to keep this project in your prayers as it may move quickly.

Again, my staff and I thank you for all that you do to help financially support the parish, from raffles to Sunday offertory. It's wonderful to be a part of a great supporting parish that not only supports itself but can support the good work of Saint Augustine Hunger Center, education at Lakewood Catholic Academy, and the many other groups that we help.
