

The Dead of the Parish

THE story of St. Clement's parish would indeed be incomplete, did we not make mention of those who labored with us during the strenuous days of organization and building, but who were called from their labors by the angel of death before the day of the church's official dedication to God. Since we can take with us into the next world nothing but our good works, we may be sure that our deceased fellow-members and friends whose helping hands in the upbuilding of the parish we miss so keenly, were not without merit as they stood before the justice-seat of God. May God have mercy on their souls. Every time the priest stands at the altar, and every time their fellow-members come to assist at the holy sacrifice, they shall be mindful of the privilege God gave them to continue the good work begun by those who have gone, and our prayers will be offered for the repose of their souls. It is a beautiful custom to commemorate year after year the anniversary of the death of our loved ones. If possible, a Requiem High-mass should be sung for the repose of their souls, and the relatives and friends who mourn their loss, should if possible, receive Holy Communion at the mass. If the day of death cannot be chosen for the mass because it falls on a Sunday or a Great Feast Day, then choose the nearest free day for the anniversary. If there are several deceased to be commemorated, choose one day that will serve as an anniversary for them all.
