ADORATION CHAPEL

Fourth Sunday of Lent March 27, 2022

The parable of the prodigal son: "...we must celebrate and rejoice, because your brother was dead and has come to life again..." Luke 15: 1-3, 11-32

The prodigal is not a simple story with a clear and easy-to-embrace moral. Children often have no idea how much their parents do and would do for them; many good parents don't realize what their love for their sons and daughters enables them to do. In the parable of the prodigal son, Jesus holds up the boy's father as a model of compassion and reconciliation. He runs to greet his son and embraces him; he welcomes his son home with no recriminations, no conditions, no rancor. The father has never lost hope in his son's return; his love has survived the hurt and anguish of his son's leaving.

Forgiveness is focused on the future, about healing the past in order to live joyfully and meaningfully in the present. May God's complete and unconditional love, mirrored in the love of the prodigal's father, embrace our hearts enabling us to both forgive and seek forgiveness and so re-create our futures in Easter joy.


