<u>Twenty-Seventh Sunday of the Year</u> October 2, 2022

"If you have faith the size of a mustard seed, you would say to this mulberry tree, 'Be uprooted and planted in the sea,' and it would obey you." Luke 17: 5-10

Mustard seed faith is the conviction that our few cents, when added to another's few cents, can accomplish great things on the scale of casting mulberry trees into the sea. Such faith requires hard work, trust and commitment to the common good, and a vision of hope in the possibilities before us. These small village savings and loans mirror Jesus' Gospel of the mustard seed - that what is small, seemingly insignificant and all but invisible can produce great things in the scheme of God. The Gospel mustard seed - whether in the form of ingenuity, commitment, empathy, or a few pennies - challenges us to grab hold of the opportunities we have for planting and reaping a harvest of justice, compassion and reconciliation in our villages and communities.




