# Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

Jehruary 19, 2023

"But I say to you, love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you, that you may be children of your heavenly Father, for He makes the sun rise on the bad and the good, and causes the rain to fall on the just and the unjust."

Matthew 5: 38

On His teachings on loving one's enemies, Jesus challenges us to break the cycle of fear, hatred and vengeance that ensnares us and society by realizing how self-centered interests diminish the dreams and hopes of others. Only in seeing the griefs and disappointments of those we love, and of those we find difficult to love, can we begin to move beyond feelings of bitterness and demands for retribution. Such a greater understanding of the impact of our own actions and seeking the greater good of the community are the heart of Jesus' Gospel. The faithful disciple seeks to break that destructive rut of hatred and distrust by taking that formidable first step to love, to trust, to heal, to be reconciled with those from whom we are separated.

# Children's Liturgy of the Word at Saint Clement is Coming Back!

Starting Sunday, February 26th, at the 9 am Mass.

What happens at the Children's Liturgy of the Word?



After the opening prayers, and before the first reading, Father will call the children to the front. We process out to the gathering area where we have a table covered in the liturgical color and a lit candle to represent the presence of Jesus. The children sit and listen to the

readings, they respond to the psalm, they stand for the Alleluia, and listen to the Gospel. These readings are the same as the adult Mass, but are translated for children. The children then share a word that they heard in one of the readings and we share our thoughts. We conclude with intentions where each child has the opportunity to say who they would like to pray for. At the offertory the children rejoin their families. **Who is welcome?** All young children are welcome!
