The parable of the sower.

Matthew 13: 1-23

In the first part of Jesus' parable of the sower, the seed sown is the Word of God - but in the second part of the image, the seed is the individual in whom the Word of God takes root. We become the Word that was planted within our hearts; we are the harvest of God's justice and compassion. It is a struggle, to be sure - but allowing ourselves to be "planted," to be broken, to grow, is to become the Word that God has planted within us. Jesus challenges us to be both sower and seed - to sow seeds of encouragement, joy and reconciliation regardless of the "ground" on which it is scattered, and to imitate the seed's total giving of self that becomes the harvest of Gospel justice and mercy.

The Upcoming Elections

In June, all the priests of our Diocese met regarding the upcoming August and November elections, among other issues. Of course, we cannot tell you how to vote. However, we encourage you to be informed on issues as they arise.

A special election will take place in Ohio on August 8, 2023, to vote on Issue 1, which asks voters if Ohio should "Require that any proposed amendment to the Constitution of the State of Ohio receive the approval of at least 60 percent of eligible voters on the proposed amendment." In this August election, there are many strongly encouraging a yes vote, while others are strongly encouraging a no vote. That seems to invite some careful study of why these two sides are so strongly committed to their point of view. The Bishops of Ohio do not have a position on Issue 1 as it does not have moral content. As our Bishops remind us, "responsible citizenship is a virtue, and participation in political life is a moral obligation," (Faithful Citizenship, No. 13) and so we urge you to register and vote in the special election.

As we look ahead to the November 7 election, there is an effort to amend the State constitution to expand and enshrine abortion at the expense of protections for both women and unborn children. This would seem to be a clearer decision for us as far as Catholic teaching is concerned. Our Holy Father, Pope Francis reminds us that "Our defense of the innocent unborn ... needs to be clear, firm and passionate, for at stake is the dignity of a human life, which is always sacred and demands love for each person, regardless of his or her stage of development" (*Gaudete et Exsultate*, no. 101).
