The parable of the King's wedding banquet: "Tell those invited: Behold, I have prepared my banquet, my calves and fattened cattle are killed, and everything is ready, come to the feast." But when the King came in to meet the guests, He saw a man there not dressed in a wedding garment. The King said to him, "My friend, how is it that you are in here without a wedding garment?' But he was reduced to silence." Matthew 22: 1-14

In today's Gospel, Jesus articulates the Father's vision for humanity - a "banquet" at which all are respected and honored for who they are and the goodness they bring to the King's table. If we are to be truly faithful to God's vision, the compassion of God must transform our heart's perspective, enabling us to see beyond ethnic stereotypes, economic distinctions, class and celebrity, to recognize every man, woman and child as made in the same image and likeness of God in which we were all created. We must be willing both to give joyfully what we have and to accept humbly what others bring to the table. God's "banquet" is only realized when we embrace a radically new vision of humanity, a perspective that ignores suspicions, doubts and stereotypes and, instead, recognizes everyone, first, as a child of God, worthy of respect, love and compassion.
