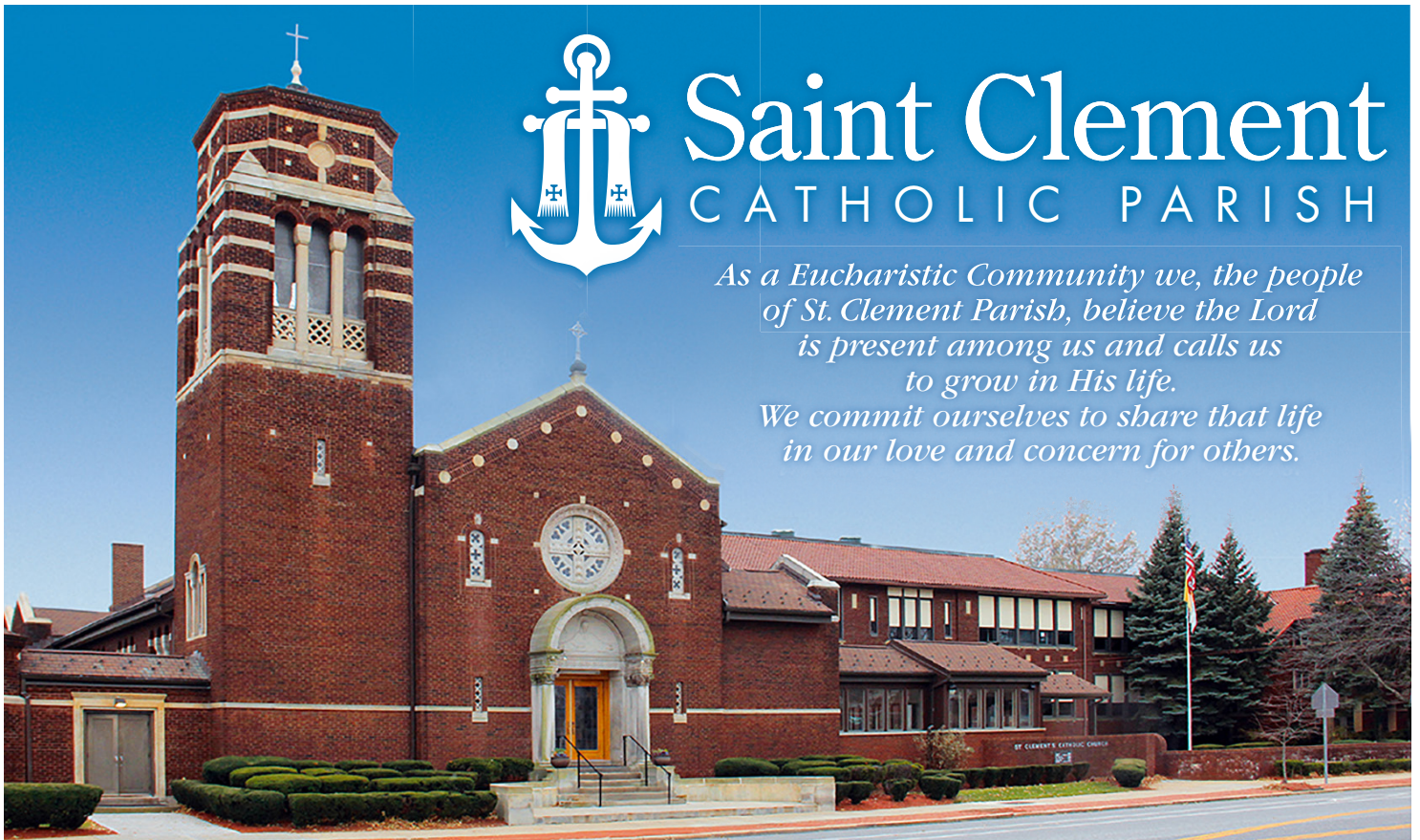

*"You shall love the Lord, your God, with all your heart ... You shall love your neighbor as yourself."
Matthew 22: 34-40*

To love as God loves requires us first to see each other as God sees us: to look beyond labels and brands to recognize the goodness every human being possesses simply by being created in the loving image of God. The only way we can meaningfully love God is to realize that we are connected to one another by such love. In these deeply divisive times, the words of Jesus in today's Gospel are especially challenging: to love with our whole heart and soul and mind requires us to put aside our anger and mistrust of those who see issues from a different perspective and to engage one another in love and compassion as God is engaged with us. When asked which is the greatest of all the commandments, Jesus connects love of God to love of neighbor: in loving others we find ourselves able to love God. Such love begins with an awareness of God's presence in every element of creation and in every human heart. To love our neighbor as ourselves is to see others as we see ourselves: realizing that the dreams and hopes we hold for ourselves and our families are the same dreams and hopes others hold for themselves and their families.
