conversion that can take place in one's life when we focus our excitement on living out the mysteries that we look to encounter. Through converting our hearts to these mysteries, we will be imbued with God's excitement for us.



"Prayer is what keeps the lamp of the heart lit. This is especially true when we feel that our enthusiasm has cooled down. Prayer relights it, because it brings us back to God, to the center of things. Prayer reawakens the soul from sleep and focuses it on what matters, on the purpose of existence. Even during our busiest days, we must not neglect prayer. The prayer of the heart can be helpful for us, repeating often brief invocations. For example, during Advent we could make a habit of saying, "Come, Lord Jesus." Only these words, but repeating them - "Come, Lord Jesus". This time of preparation leading to Christmas is beautiful, we think of the Nativity scene and Christmas, so let us say from the heart - "Come, Lord Jesus".
