Fifth Sunday of Lent March 17, 2024

"Unless a grain of wheat falls to the ground and dies, it remains just a grain of wheat; but if it dies, it produces much fruit." John 12: 20-33

The grain of wheat is a sign of hope in the resurrection despite our Good Fridays, of God's enabling us to turn our lives around and up into the light of joy and fulfillment, of the ultimate triumph of light over darkness, of goodness over evil, of life over death. The broken grain of wheat teaches us an important lesson about love - that the risk of continuing on despite the obstacles and of losing some part of ourselves for the sake of someone else is the price of love. But in taking on the hard work of loving as God loves, we experience the harvest of the grain - in our willingness to "die" to our fears, to put aside our own needs and wants, to struggle through the darkness and muck, to let our lives be pulled apart, we discover love that can only be of God. Christ gave His life on the tree of the cross in order that new life might come forth. In taking up our own crosses with Christ's selflessness and compassion, we can transform our lives and the lives of those around us in the complete joy of Easter.




