June 8, 2025 Pentecost Sunday John 20:19-23

When I was a seminarian almost 20 years ago, a bank vice president taught us etiquette classes. She said, "Gentlemen, please make sure your breath isn't bad. Take some breath mints before you hear confessions, okay?" We nervously laughed because the proximity that makes breath noticeable (whether pleasant or not) can be a bit awkward.

When Jesus breathes on his Apostles (John 20:22), he must have been within inches of at least some of them. This closeness of his breath has a purpose: the purpose of forgiveness of sins. "Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them" (John 20:23). Why in the world would the almost uncomfortable closeness of his breath forgive sins?

In the Bible, breath is spirit or wind. It comes from above and makes that which is below to have identity. To not have a single identity is to be multiple, divided. The word "sin" comes from an ancient word that means "to split" or "render asunder." Sin divides us sinners and the world around us; our spiritual "breath" leaves us and our identity splinters. Only breath from above restores. For example, a shattered vase is rendered whole because the craftsman breathes the spirit of the vase back into it when he repairs it. A human being shattered by sin is made whole by the breath of God, breathed by Jesus through his priests. His breath alone forgives sins. It's always done with his gentle, loving closeness.

"Receive the Holy Spirit" Living the Mystery of Pentecost

This Sunday, we celebrate Pentecost, one of the great solemnities of the Church and the dramatic conclusion to the Easter season. Fifty days after the Resurrection, the risen Christ fulfills His promise to send the Holy Spirit upon the apostles. What began in fear behind locked doors is transformed into bold proclamation and joyful witness. The Holy Spirit descends with power—tongues of fire, rushing wind, and hearts set ablaze. And with that, the Church is born.

But Pentecost is more than a moment in history. It is a mystery we live now. St. Paul reminds us that "no one can say, 'Jesus is Lord,' except by the Holy Spirit" (1 Cor 12:3). Every time we pray, every time we are moved to forgive, to serve, to love—this is the Holy Spirit at work. The Catechism teaches that the Holy Spirit is "the principal agent of the Church's mission" (CCC 852). It is the Spirit who animates our parishes, enlivens the sacraments, and sends us forth to bear witness to Christ in the world.

In our Lakewood Catholic parishes, we are invited to recognize and respond to that same Spirit working in our midst. We see the Spirit alive when children receive First Communion, when adults come forward to be baptized and confirmed, when someone brings food to a neighbor in need, when ministries of mercy and welcome are carried out quietly, faithfully, and without recognition. These are not just "good deeds"—they are signs of the Spirit's power still at work in the Church.

Yet the Spirit does not force Himself upon us. He is received in prayer, welcomed in humility, and followed with courage. Like the first apostles, we may feel unsure or unworthy—but Pentecost reminds us: God does not call the equipped; He equips the called.

As we come to the end of the Easter season, let us not think of Pentecost as a conclusion but as a commissioning. The gifts of the Spirit—wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, piety, and fear of the Lord—are not given to be admired, but to be used. Now is the time to take what we have received and go forth in faith.

Let us pray together:

Come, Holy Spirit. Fill the hearts of your faithful. Enkindle in us the fire of your love. Send forth your Spirit, and we shall be created—and you shall renew the face of the earth.




