

August 17, 2025 20th Sunday in Ordinary Time Luke 12:49-53

During my baseball career, my best coach often said, "You shouldn't be worried if I yell at you. Be worried if I don't. If I stop pushing you, it means I don't think you have any more potential." He demanded a lot, and I knew it meant he saw that I could be something special on the baseball field.

Jesus says some demanding words to us this week. "Do you think I have come to establish peace on the earth?" he asks, "No, tell you, but rather division" (Luke 12:51). He wants you and me-in fact, all the earth-to participate in the luminous glory of God. That's why he speaks of himself as a divine arsonist. Divine fire is like a good coach: it demands the removal of all that obstructs the achievement of the lofty goal.

How is your life demanding right now? That inconvenient family situation, the unfair boss at work, the kids who reject their parents' wishes, the nagging health issue? Maybe things would be more peaceful devoid of these seemingly arbitrary difficulties. But for us who believe in the one who comes to set the earth of fire, we should be much more worried if he stops demanding so much from us. In fact, let's thank him for it. He sees how glorious we can become.



## Did you know?

In the 1930's complicated financial problems faced St. James as the church was under construction during the darkest days of the Depression. For a time the apse was left unpainted until funds were available to complete the decoration.

Do you know who the mural figures represent? Above the high altar is Our Lord in glory, enthroned in Heaven. Around Him are the figures of the Blessed Virgin, St. Joseph, and four of the Archangels. St. Michael holds his flaming sword with which he slays Satan. St. Gabriel is given the lily of the Annunciation and scepter, and a scroll which reads "God is my Strength" while St. Uriel holds a scroll with the words "God is my Light". In the background are adoring angels.

Below this is the Apostolic Frieze, running around the apse. Each of the apostles is represented along with his familiar symbol. St. Peter with his keys, and at the opposite end, St. James with his cross sword and the shell denoting pilgrimage. Between them are St. Andrew, St. John, St. Philp, St. Bartholomew, St. Thomas, St. James Minor, St. Matthew, St. Jude, St. Simon, and St. Matthias. Each is depicted with objects symbolizing his martyrdom or some important event in his life.

Overhead is the Arch of the Holy Sacraments. Baptism is shown by the font, Confirmation by the dove, the Holy Eucharist by the chalice and host, Penance by two crossed keys, Anointing of the Sick by the oil stock, Ordination by a chalice and paten resting on a missal, and Matrimony by two clasped hands. Were you able to identify these symbols and what they represent?


## Join the St. Vincent de Paul Ministry - Serve Our Neighbors in Need






