Twenty-Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

Luke 17:5-10

A priest friend of mine received a call from a family whose elderly mother was dying. Within thirty minutes, he was at her bedside, offering the consolation of the sacraments, anointing her with the oil of the sick, and commending her soul to God. She passed not long after, and for months, her family spoke of their deep gratitude for his presence. When I phoned him to commend his faithful ministry, he simply said, "I was just doing my job."

His words brought to mind Jesus' teaching this week in Luke 17:10: "So you also, when you have done everything you were told to do, should say, 'We are unworthy servants; we have only done our duty.'" In a world that often seeks recognition and applause, the Lord invites us into a different mindset — one of humble service. The priest did not see his response as extraordinary; he saw it as a grace to fulfill his vocation.

How tempting it is to seek affirmation for doing what I ought to do! Yet Jesus reminds us that true discipleship is not about grandstanding but about quiet faithfulness. It is enough to have served. It is enough to have loved. It is enough to be grateful that we were given the chance to do our duty in the first place. Whether in priesthood, parenthood, or any vocation, what peace-soaked freedom there is in simply doing what is asked of us. No more, no less. Jesus, that is how you quietly love us.

Mission Trip to El Salvador – Registration Now Open

St. Luke Parish has two mission trips to El Salvador planned in 2026. Registration is now open for the first trip scheduled for February 4–8. Space is limited to 18 travelers, and the deadline to reserve your spot is October 1, 2025. This pilgrimage will include visits to holy sites of the Salvadoran martyrs, the delivery of donations and engagement with students, home visits filled with prayer and gratitude, opportunities to enjoy El Salvador's natural beauty, and cultural immersion that deepens our appreciation of the Body of Christ. The cost is \$1,800 per person, covering airfare, hotel on the Pacific Ocean, meals, in-country transportation, and the guidance of experienced Salvadoran hosts and interpreters through our partnership with St. Dominic Parish. Chiltiupan High School Scholarship Program

The El Salvador Ministry in 2025 launched a new scholarship program that supports 10 high school students with the cost of transportation and lunches. High schools are much further from the remote cantóns, so many students cannot afford the time, transportation and lunch cost to attend. Consequently, too many students simply stop attending and begin working but have very limited job opportunities. Without such support, students frequently end their education after grade school. Cost for a full school year is \$850 per student. Please consider sponsoring a student or making a donation for this purpose. 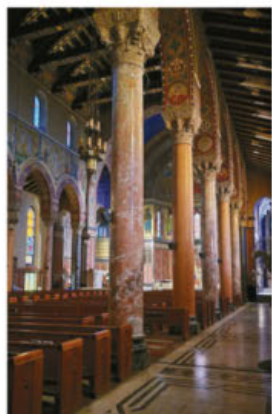
