### The Dedication of the Lateran Basilica

#### John 2:13-22

When I was 22, I entered St. Peter's Basilica for the first time. It floored me. I could hardly take it in, its grandeur, majestic arches, vibrant colors, and the light that danced through its high windows. Somehow, amidst such splendor, I felt an overwhelming sense of belonging, as if I had finally come home.

Jesus reorients how we Catholics see sacred buildings. In today's Gospel he says, "Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up" (John 2:13-22). His riddle implies, shockingly, that his own body is now the fundamental dwelling place of God and humanity. The temple in Jerusalem has been superseded.

In our churches today — whether they mirror the basilica's grandeur or embrace humble simplicity — we experience architectural symbols of Christ's risen body. It is no accident we call them "churches": they make visible in brick-and-mortar Christ's body which is made up of the living stones we call Christians. Each church building, like St. John Lateran in Rome, or St. Peter's, or any other, is meant to be a vibrant sign of Christ's resurrected body. We should cherish and protect our churches as places where heaven touches earth, where we, as a community, are raised to the fullness of life in Christ.

### Our Lakewood Seminarians

This is the second of three articles written by the Avilas to introduce you to our seminarians. We hope they will prompt you to join us in praying for these men.

Sean Homcy's home parish is St. James, where his family was very involved in activities while he was growing up. He thought of becoming a priest when he was about 12 or 13. He was not sure how to approach this, but eventually God led him to Fr. Michael McCandless, who influenced him to apply to St. Mary's and taught him what vocation discernment was - action, not just abstract thought.

At the seminary, he likes the strong sense of community and fraternity that is centered on Christ. This has helped him grow closer to Jesus through the friendships he has formed. The prayer and liturgy structures, academics, and communal life have been very beneficial to him. He is drawn to the priesthood by the call to serve as an intercessor for the people of God. The ordained priest shares in Christ's role as a sacrificial victim on behalf of the people. He brings people into a deeper union with God, especially through the sacraments.

His advice for someone discerning a vocation is to commit time to prayer. He also recommends bringing your questions to God, your pastor, or another priest you trust. The seminary is a very healthy and helpful environment in which to discern a vocation.
