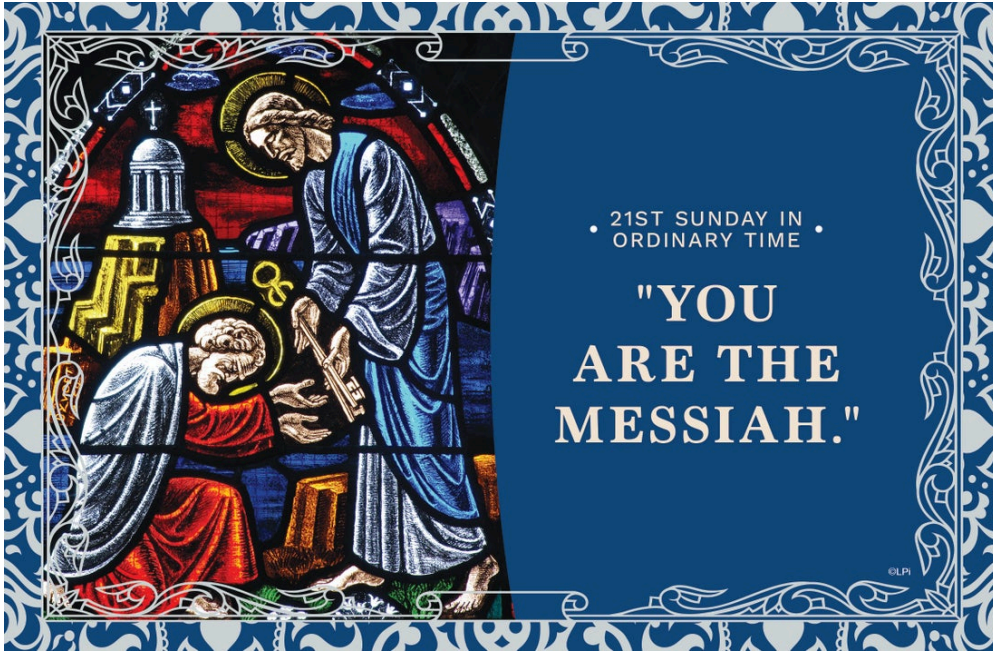

SACRAMENTS

BAPTISM

Baptism is the first sacrament of initiation into the Catholic Church. Parents seeking Baptism for their child are invited to contact the Parish Office to begin the preparation and scheduling process. For more information, please contact the Parish Office at 216-521-0184.

MARRIAGE

Couples wishing to celebrate the Sacrament of Marriage should contact the parish as soon as possible, and at least six months before their desired wedding date. Marriage preparation is required and includes meetings with clergy and parish formation. For more information, please contact the Parish Office at 216-521-0184.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK

If you or a loved one is facing serious illness, preparing for surgery, experiencing the effects of aging, or is in danger of death, the Church offers the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick. For sacramental emergencies outside office hours, please call the parish office and follow the prompts for the emergency line.

FUNERAL & BEREAVEMENT MINISTRY

The Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA), known locally as Becoming Catholic, is for adults who are interested in learning more about the Catholic faith, preparing for Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist, or completing their sacraments. GOSPEL REFLECTION

August 23, 2026

Twenty-First Sunday in Ordinary Time

Matthew 16:13-20

The first time I stood inside St. Peter's Basilica in Rome, its majesty overwhelmed me. The sheer beauty of Michelangelo's dome seemed to lift my soul right out of my body. Later, I joined the Scavi tour that winds below the basilica, down into the ancient pagan cemetery where Peter was buried. There, in the dim light and narrow passageways, I found myself looking at the bones of a murdered Jewish fisherman, his feet cut off so his crucified body could be taken down more easily.

What a paradox. Above me, the most glorious church ever built. Beneath me, the remains of a backwater fisherman. But this man dared to answer Jesus' question, "Who do you say that I am?" And crowning that immense dome above his tomb are the words from today's Gospel, "You are Peter, and upon this rock I will build my Church."

Within you and me is the drama of the lowest and the highest. Every time we confess Christ, humbly, imperfectly, maybe even trembling, we enter that same mystery. The dust of our humanity, touched by the splendor of heaven. God's presence and our dry bones together. Humility and glory. May our lives embrace both the lowest and the highest, like that great basilica, as we profess Jesus.

PSR and Sacramental Preparation in the Lakewood Catholic Parishes

We are happy to offer several faith formation options for the Lakewood Catholic Community. Families with children in public school or non-Catholic schools are invited to consider one of the following faith formation options. Parish School of Religion programs follow the school year calendar, beginning in August/September and meeting through early May.

Parish School of Religion: Families will have one of three options to choose from.

Option 1: Family PSR - Family PSR uses the Pflaum Gospel Weekly lessons at home. Periodically throughout the year, families in this option will gather at St. Clement Church on Sundays to participate in special opportunities for fellowship, prayer, and formation with other PSR families. Families who choose this option are asked to attend a parent meeting on Sunday, September 13th at 6:30pm in the St. Clement Church Hall. New families, to ensure we have the materials for your child, please contact Colleen Houk at the parish office as soon as possible to register.

Option 2: Catechesis of the Good Shepherd - Catechesis of the Good Shepherd is a Montessori-inspired approach to the religious formation of children, rooted in Sacred Scripture, liturgy, and respect for the child's rich relationship with God. The children gather in a specially prepared space called an Atrium. A typical session includes prayer, a presentation on Scripture or liturgy, and time for the children to work with the prepared materials and quietly ponder the mysteries presented. The Level 1 Atrium is prepared for children ages 3–6 years old (K). Children must be potty trained and bathroom independent. The Level 2 Atrium is prepared for children ages 6–9 (1st–3rd grade), and Level 3 is available for those in grades 4 and up, with previous Level 2 experience. We are happy to offer the following times: Mondays from 4:00pm–5:30pm and Wednesdays from 6:30pm–8:00pm.

This QR code will provide a short video further explaining the beauty of Catechesis of the Good Shepherd.
Please note that this option is offered at St. James Parish. To register, please contact Colleen Houk at the parish office.

Option 3: Traditional Classroom PSR Model - Students meet by grade level with catechists at St. Luke Church to engage in meaningful lessons. Students study from the Sophia Institute Spirit of Truth series. This option takes place on Mondays from 6:30pm–7:30pm. Classroom PSR will begin in mid-September. Please visit the St. Luke website for more information and to register.

Sacramental Preparation:

Sacramental preparation for First Reconciliation/First Holy Communion and Confirmation is in addition to PSR attendance and Catholic school. Students from the parishes will prepare together for the reception of the sacraments. Preparation for Reconciliation and First Holy Communion traditionally begins when students are in their 2nd grade year, while preparation for Confirmation traditionally begins during the 7th grade and continues through the 8th grade year.

First Holy Communion Families: A parent meeting will be held on Tuesday, September 22nd at 6:30pm in the St. James Parish Hall. If you have not yet registered, please contact Colleen Houk as soon as possible to ensure we have the materials for your child.

Confirmation Families: Please visit the "Confirmation Preparation" page of the St. Luke Parish website for additional information and to register your child for preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation. Also, please keep an eye out for emails from Max Hall regarding preparation for this sacrament.

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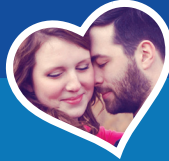
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
